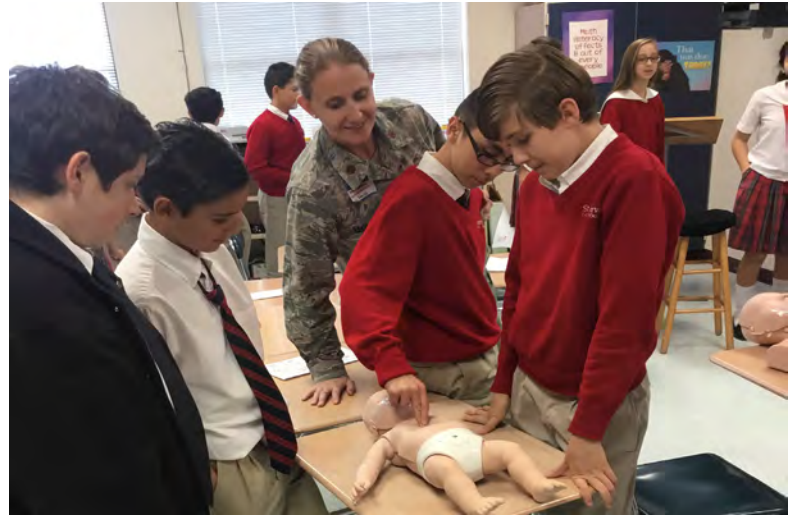
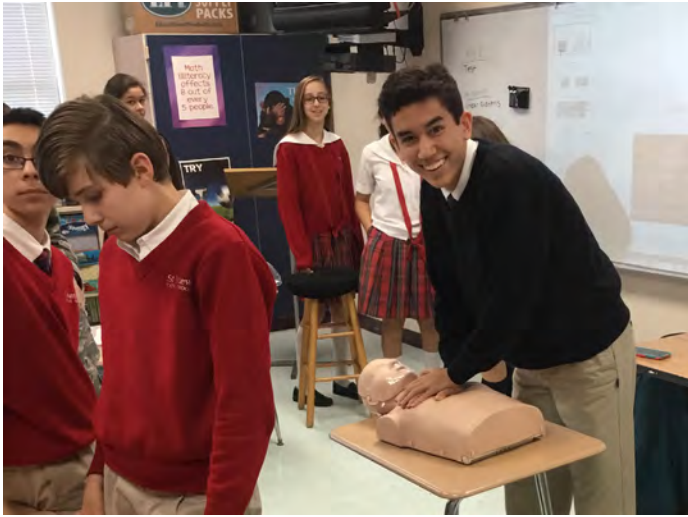

Each family is responsible for 10 hours and must document them on Renweb. Instructions are as follows:

1. Login to your Renweb account. Our District code is: SM-TX  
You will also need your login & password.
2. You will see a tab on the main page called "Family Information." Click on this tab.
3. On the "Family Information" page, you will see tabs with the names for each Parent and Child in your family. Click on the name of the individual who volunteered their time. You will see tabs for "Contact Info" & "Service Hours".
4. Click on the Service Hours tab. In the new window, click on "Add Service Hours". Scroll through the description box and select the appropriate category. If you do not see an accurate description of your contribution, you may select "Other Donation or Service" and add a description in the "Note" section.
5. Remember to enter the number of hours you served and SAVE your entry. Done!
